Field bindweed is a Perennial with an extensive prostrate root system that can be from 1'- 4' in length which can climb like a vine or form dense mats. It was introduced from Europe and has become a widespread and serious weed which can adapt to grow as high as 10,000' above sea level. It may flower from June well into the fall and has several alias names: creeping jenny and wild morning glory.
